## Porter Spartan Band Boosters Band Scholarship

The Porter High School Spartan Band Boosters exist to promote and encourage the development of the best high school band program possible. The same core values that the directors instill in the band students (Discipline, Honor, Integrity, Commitment) are the values by which we operate. The scholarship review process will seek to award applicants who demonstrate those core values during their time in band and as they continue their education following graduation.

### **Minimum Eligibility Requirements**

Applicant must be a current member of the PHS Spartan Band, and:

- 1) Is maintaining at least a B average in Band
- 2) Regularly participates in after-school rehearsals, performances, auditions, etc
- 3) Carries at least a 2.5 grade point average in all classes
- 4) Must have been a member of the PHS Spartan Band for their junior and senior year
- 5) Application must be complete to be considered
- 6) Applicant must be in his / her senior year of high school
- 7) The parent/guardian of the applicant must meet the volunteer criteria set forth in the bylaws.

### **Application Requirements**

- 1) Completed application returned by the first Monday in April in a sealed envelope
- 2) Teacher forms must be returned by the first Monday in April in a sealed envelope

3) A letter of acceptance, copy of the signature page of the admission application, or comparable documentation to demonstrate intent to attend an institution of higher learning, including, but not limited to, a community college, university, or career/technical school.

### **Selection Process**

Applications will be reviewed and scored by a selection committee named by the Band Booster president. Parents of senior band students will not be eligible to serve on this committee. The directors will be ex-officio members of the committee in order to provide input on the applicant's role and participation in the Spartan Band program.

Applications will be scored based on participation in rehearsals, performances and fund raising activities, number of instrumental / auxiliary performing groups, auditions for region / state band, Solo &

Ensemble, etc., as well as attitude, reliability, essays, teacher recommendations, director recommendations, and parent involvement.

Ties will be broken in the following manner: (in order)

- 1) Highest average in the current band class
- 2) Highest overall GPA
- 3) The scholarship money will be distributed evenly among the tied applicants.

### **Announcement and Payment**

Recipients will be announced at the end of the year Band Banquet. Scholarship monies will be paid directly into the student account at the institution of higher learning, once the freshman semester has begun.

All applicants receiving scholarships must maintain the same high level of discipline, honor, integrity and commitment in their conduct that caused the committee to award them the scholarships. Failure to uphold the core values of the PHS Spartan Band or any defamation of the PHS Spartan Band or its directors will result in a review by the Band Booster officers and a possible revocation of the scholarship award. By submitting this scholarship application, all applicants and their parents agree to abide by the decisions of both the scholarship committee and the booster club officers as it pertains to the scholarship award AND give consent to release grades to all teachers asked to complete application documents.
